- Be an enthusiastic, professional, and exemplary representative of MSVU.
- Be interested in fostering a positive connection between students and MSVU.
- Be interested in developing personal and team leadership skills.
- Have effective communication and group facilitation skills.
- Be able to analyze situations and make decisions in the best interest of all parties.
