

# International Education Centre Post Graduation Work Permit (PGWP) Application

You must apply for the Post-Graduation Work Permit with a valid Study Permit and within 90 days of receiving your Eligibility to Graduate Letter/Program Completion letter. **Important**: as soon as you receive all your final grades, you can request this letter from the Registrar's Office as it is not automatically issued to students who are graduating. PGWP eligibility requirements. <u>View PGWP eligibility requirements</u>.

NOTE: if you missed the 90-day period or if your Study Permit has expired please contact your Immigration Advisor.

## 1. Log in to your online immigration account using GCkey or Sign-in Partner

\*If you are a new user, you will need to create your account through GCKey or Sign-in Partner.

NOTE: Save your username and password. Consider taking a screenshot of all your security questions and answers to avoid getting locked out of your account. Once you are locked out of your account, you will never be able to access it ever again.



Under <u>Application Form(s)</u>. Click on the document "Application to Change Conditions...". After clicking it, a new webpage will open up. The webpage will say "Please Wait...". You don't have to wait. Immediately press the download button of your web browser. Save the PDF file on your laptop. Go to the folder where you saved the file. Right click on the file and choose "Open with Adobe Acrobat" PDF Reader. Fill it out using a computer and not by hand/print.



## Program Completion Letter and Official Transcripts

For the Program Completion Letter/Eligibility to Graduate Letter, you have to fill out the <u>Letter Request</u> Form and email it to <u>heather.standing@msvu.ca</u> and if she is on vacation, you can email it to <u>stephanie.hale@msvu.ca</u>.

**NOTE:** When filling out the form, you must choose **all** of the following options:

- Eligibility to Graduate
- Visa Letter
- And Other option box of Visa Letter, choose "Post-Graduation Work Permit

For Official Transcripts, you can go in-person to receive it right away OR you can fill out the <u>Transcript</u> Request Form and email it to transcripts@msvu.ca.

#### Medical Exam

**IMPORTANT:** in-Canada applications only

IRCC created a <u>temporary public policy</u> for immigration medical exams (IMEs) <u>until October 5, 2029 only</u>. If you completed an IME within the past 5 years, submit a copy of your previous medical exam.

To qualify for this temporary policy, you must meet all of these conditions:

- You applied, or are applying, for either permanent residence or temporary residence.
- You already live in Canada.
- You completed your previous IME in the last 5 years.
- Your previous IME indicated a low risk or no risk to public health or public safety.

**NOTE:** You need to submit your proof of medical exam performed by an IRCC approved physician if you plan to work in the fields of education, childcare, medical and healthcare services, nursing homes,




taking care of elderly and other vulnerable people, hospital, and agriculture, etc. Click on this link to <u>view</u> the list of IRCC approved physicians by country to book your appointment if necessary.

#### Proof of English Language Proficiency

Starting November 1, 2024, PGWP applicants from a university are required to submit proof of English proficiency with a score equivalent to Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) 7 and above. Read more here.

Mount Saint Vincent University is a designated CELPIP test centre so you can complete the test on-campus.

#### How to book your test at MSVU?

- Select General Test → Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship Canada → Permanent Residence/Temporary
   Residence → Canada → Nova Scotia → Halifax → look for MSVU

#### How long does it take?

- The total test time is under 3 hours and is done in one sitting.
  - Listening (47–55 minutes): Listen to passages and answer questions
  - o Reading (55–60 minutes): Read passages and answer questions
  - o Writing (53–60 minutes): Respond to questions with written answers
  - Speaking (15–20 minutes): Reply to on-screen prompts verbally

#### How much does it cost?

\$290 plus tax

#### How to prepare?

- Free Practice: Free Practice Tests CELPIP
- Purchase of Study Materials: Paid Study Materials CELPIP

#### What to bring with you?

Required ID for the test registration: your original passport (no photocopy or electronic copies)

#### Where is the test exam?

Seton Academic building room 331 (the computer lab)

#### How and when to get your test score?

Log in to your CELPIP account 3-4 business days after your test date.
