

Study Permit Restoration inside Canada

Only use this guide if your Study Permit has already expired and if it is <u>within 90 days of expiry</u>. If your permit is still valid, please use the guide 'Study Permit Renewal Guide'. If your Study Permit has expired for more than 90 days, please book an appointment with the International Education Centre ASAP. NOTE: that if your passport is expiring, you must apply for a new passport before applying for your study permit.

1. Log in to your online immigration account using GCkey or Sign-in Partner

*If you are a new user, you will need to create your account through GCKey or Sign-in Partner. NOTE: Save your username and password. Consider taking a screenshot of all your security questions and answers to avoid getting locked out of your account. Once you are locked out of your account, you will never be able to access it ever again.

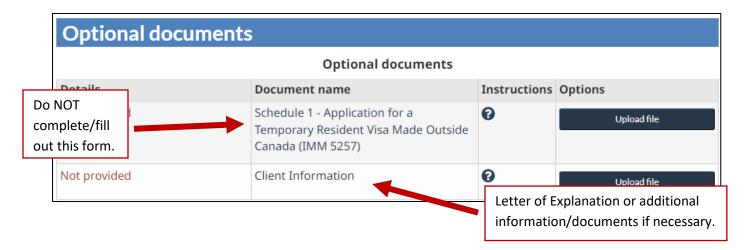

INSTRUCTIONS: You need to download the Adobe Acrobat Reader application to your computer.

Under <u>Application Form(s)</u>, Click on the document "Application to Change Conditions...". After clicking it, a new webpage will open up. The webpage will say "Please Wait...". You don't have to wait. Immediately press the download button of your web browser. Save the PDF file on your laptop. Go to the folder where you saved the file. Right click on the file and choose "Open with Adobe Acrobat" PDF Reader. Fill it out using a computer and not by hand/print.

Enrolment Letter and Official Transcripts

For the enrolment letter, fill out the <u>Letter Request Form</u> and email it to <u>heather.standing@msvu.ca</u> and if she is on vacation, you can email it to <u>stephanie.hale@msvu.ca</u>.

Note: When filling out the form, you must choose all of the following options:

- Confirmation of Enrolment Letter
- Visa Letter
- Extension of permit renewal
- and Other option box of Visa Letter, you should write 'Study Permit'.

For Official Transcripts, you can go in-person to receive it right away OR you can fill out the <u>Transcript</u> <u>Request Form</u> and email it to <u>transcripts@msvu.ca</u>.

Medical Exam

IMPORTANT: in-Canada applications only

IRCC created a <u>temporary public policy</u> for immigration medical exams (IMEs) <u>until October 5, 2029 only</u>. If you completed an IME within the past 5 years, submit a copy of your previous medical exam.

To qualify for this temporary policy, you must meet **all** of these conditions:

- You applied, or are applying, for either permanent residence or temporary residence.
- You already live in Canada.
- You completed your previous IME in the last 5 years.
- Your previous IME indicated a low risk or no risk to public health or public safety.

NOTE: You need to submit your proof of medical exam performed by an IRCC approved physician if you plan to work in the fields of education, childcare, medical and healthcare services, nursing homes, taking care of elderly and other vulnerable people, hospital, and agriculture, etc. Click on this link to <u>view the list</u> of IRCC approved physicians by country to book your appointment if necessary.
