Glossary of Terms Discussed

Add/Drop Deadline: The date each term, usually the payment deadline, that students must drop courses by to receive a full refund. It is also the last date students can add new courses for the current term.

Guard.Me: The insurance company used by MSVU for international student medical insurance.

Information Release Form: A document students must complete if they wish to give a third party (friend, family, sponsor, etc.) access to their financial or registration information.

International Student Medical: International Students are automatically signed up and charged for an annual emergency medical insurance.

MSI Card: A provincial health card for Nova Scotia Medical Services Insurance.

myMount: Where students can register for classes, view financial information and more.

UPASS: The U-Pass is a sticker you add to your student ID card, which provides unlimited bus and ferry service in the HRM.







Payment Due Dates are found in your myMount account under the Money Matters tile or at msvu.ca/tuition.

Financial Services also sends emails each term advising of the deadlines.

Students must pay the required fee instalment by each term's payment deadlines (listed below) in order to complete their registration and keep their course selections for that term.

Payment deadlines:

Fall 2024 Term - September 11, 2024 Winter 2025 Term - January 13, 2025

There are financial penalties applied to accounts not paid in full by the deadlines each term.

- ☐ Electronic payment preferred:
 - ■Within Canada –bill payment option through online banking (app or browser) your 7-digit student ID number is the account number
 - ■International payments preferred option Convera for students (formerly Global Pay for Students) – also have bank wire option
 - •Allow 2 to 3 days for receipt and posting
- ☐ Credit cards are not accepted for tuition and residence payments
 - International debit cards are not accepted at the Financial Services counters



Withdrawal from Classes

- ☐ September 11, 2024 last date to drop Fall 2024 classes without academic or financial penalty
- Refund Schedule Applies after September 11th with declining pro-rated refund
- □ If you decide not to attend or visa not approved, make sure you drop your courses by September 11th, 2024

- ☐ Automatically charged \$654.00 for September 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025
- ☐ Opt Outs:
 - ✓ If you are taking courses from out of country
 - Complete opt out form email <u>financial.services@msvu.ca</u> no later than September 11th, 2024
 - ✓ If you are covered under MSI (Nova Scotia Medical Services Insurance)
 - Send copy of MSI card to <u>financial.services@msvu.ca</u> by September 11th, 2024
 - Effective date must be September 1/24 or earlier
 - If expiry date is before Aug 31/25 will need to send copy of replacement card before expiry
- ☐ Students who opt-out of the International Student Medical with an MSI card, will be automatically enrolled in the Student Union plan.
- □ If you will receive your MSI card prior to December 31st, 2024 then please email financial.services@msvu.ca

What is the U-Pass?

Instead of buying bus tickets or monthly passes, full-time students can use the U-Pass.

U-PASS Program

outside of Halifax Regional Municipality

☐ All graduate and undergraduate students who are registered full-time in credit course work at MSVU in the term for which the U-Pass is being issued, will receive a U-Pass. □Great value – a bus pass purchased through Halifax Transit is \$90/month ☐ Pick up your ID Card from the Library ☐ Once you have your ID card, go to Financial Services in Evaristus Hall to get the U-PASS sticker if eligible ☐ UPASS stickers can also be picked up in the Library from August 26th to September 6th, 2024 ☐ Can only opt out if you are 100% in online courses or on a co-op work term

This form must be completed by the student in order for a parent or additional persons, other than the student, to have access to that student's enrolment and financial information,





Tuition Fee Reduction Policy

□When two or more siblings are enrolled in their first undergraduate degree, are dependent upon their parents for support, live in the same household, and attend Mount Saint Vincent University full-time, full tuition is charged for the sibling with the highest tuition and half tuition is charged for each additional sibling.
☐This policy only applied to undergraduate tuition and each student must be enrolled in their first degree at MSVU.
☐This discount does not apply to summer session fees.
☐ If you and your sibling qualify for this discount, you can email financial.services@msvu.ca for the waiver form and it must be completed and returned by the payment deadline each term.
