Tuition

- Paid at the start of each semester that you are taking courses
 - September
 - January
 - May
- Depends on the number of courses you are taking
- No monthly payment option

Employment Income

- Minimum wage in Nova Scotia: \$15.20
- 24 hours/week during academic year
- Mandatory deductions (roughly 1/3 of pay cheque)
- Approximate weekly take home pay at minimum wage: \$243.20
- Approximate monthly take home pay at minimum wage: \$972.80

\$15.20*24 hrs	\$364.80
Mandatory Deductions	\$121.60
Weekly take home income	\$243.20
Monthly take home income	\$972.80
