

What to do before September: Student Checklist

Register for classes in the Fall and Winter terms. Not sure what classes to		
	Meet with an Academic Advisor to help with course selection and program planning	
	(www.msvu.ca/advising).	
	If you have or suspect you have a disability, meet with an Accessibility Advisor and	
	register with Accessibility Services.	
	Connect with your Mount Mentor. Ask them questions and learn more about what to	
	expect and how to prepare for September.	
	Get ready for Fall Orientation. The full schedule will be released in July, so keep your	
	eye on your MSVU email for more information and details.	
	Find housing for the academic year. Learn more about living on campus and what to	
	expect in residence at www.msvu.ca/residence .	
	Figure out transportation to campus.	
	 Public transit: All eligible students have unlimited access to Metro Transit Bus, 	
	Ferry, and Access-A-Bus services through their UPass. You can pick up your	
	UPass at the beginning of the Fall term.	
	 Parking is available on campus through the HotSpot app. 	
	Get started on Mount 101 (or Mount 201 if you're a transfer student). This	
_	mandatory program will be available on your Moodle account in the summer.	
	Be sure you know your MSVU student ID number and can log into myMount and	
_	Moodle using your MSVU username and password.	
Download the MSVU SAFE app.		
Ц	Get up to date on your vaccines. Talk to your health provider about additional	
_	vaccines, including the Hepatitis series and Meningococcal.
